Multi Factor Authentication (MFA)

We want all clients to have the ability to use multi-factor authentication (MFA).


This is already possible in Tractivity if a you uses SSO, but it is not possible for clients using standard Tractivity username and passwords.

MFA will mean, when enabled, that an authenticator app which will generate a time based one time password, will need to be used each time a user accesses Tractivity via the login screen.

Enabling Multi Factor Authentication (MFA)

To switch this feature on, System Admin's:


- 1. Inside System Admin, Click Edit Client from the left-hand menu.
- 2. Turn on MFA for all users or Optionally turn on MFA per user



MFA Optionally turn on MFA per user

To switch this feature on, for individual users:

- 1. Inside System Admin, and Click Edit on the user you wish to enable MFA to there login settings.
- 2. If **Login Method** of Username and Password is selected.
- 3. Enable MFA, select Yes



Select to receive a copy of all your Emails you send from Tractivity

- When a user of Tractivity Logins to the system after entering their username/password, they will see the following screen
- 2. Scan the image or use the code below
- 3. Enter 6 digit security code

Install an Authentication Application such as Microsoft Authenticator, Google Authenticator or OKTA Verify on your mobile phone.

In the app, add a new account and choose 'Work Account'

If you are unable to scan the image, enter the following information within your app:



Authenticator app


Each time a user logs into Tractivity, they will they need to enter a code from their authenticator app



Tagging Issues from the Survey Module made Easier

Rather than seeing every question from your survey, when tagging issues, you can now select which questions from your survey you wish to tag against. We know this will dramatically speed up the tagging process for many clients.

- This can be done from the View Survey Screen.
- 2. Click **Questions for Analysis** from the left-hand menu.




Choosing which Questions to Tag

Any existing surveys will have all questions enabled for tagging.

For all NEW surveys, small and long text questions will be enabled by default and other question types will be turned off for tagging.

You can use the tick box to select any other questions you would like to include in your tagging process.



Tractivity bilingual feature for English/Welsh

Tractivity is introducing a new feature, which will allow clients to select whether they wish to have bilingual for English/Welsh enabled on a project-by-project basis.

Tractivity has added the bilingual feature to any front facing stakeholder pages, this includes:

- Surveys
- Events
- Mailshot default text 'Cant see this image? Click here
- Subscription Preferences
- External Forms

Please kindly note that Tractivity's Engage 360 is not supported by the new bilingual feature.

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
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To turn on this feature


- Inside System Admin, click on the project you wish to turn bilingual for English and Welsh on.


