

Stakeholder Mapping

Tractivity's Stakeholder Mapping module will provide you with a clear view of your stakeholders and a better understanding of the impact they have on your projects

With this module you can:

- Assess your stakeholders and assign scores against a series of attributes
- Monitor changes and track their scores using charts and tables
- Analyse evolution and refine your engagement strategy accordingly


Create your Attributes

The first step in utilising Stakeholder

Mapping is to set up the attributes you'll use.

These attributes can be made specific to your needs. To set this up, you'll require **System Admin** access.

- 1. Go to System Admin
- 2. From the left-hand menu under **Configuration** click **Stakeholder Mapping Attributes**



Stakeholder Mapping Attributes

Inside this screen you'll see attributes we have set up to help determine the type of information you may wish to record against stakeholders.


- 1. You'll be able to Add Attributes
- 2. You can add a unique attribute **title**, a brief **description** and select which **Projects** the attributes are visible in (if you have multiple in the system)

You can have as many attributes as you'd like.

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System Admin: Add Stakeholder Mapping Attribute




Edit Existing Attributes


You can create new attributes but also edit them later should you need to.

- In the Stakeholder Mapping Attributes screen you have the option to Edit and Archive existing attributes.
- 2. You can then edit any prior title, description and project visibility you set up. Click **Save** when you're happy with the changes.

Please note: anything you Archive will appear in your Archive section of the system (the very top right)

You can un-archive anytime





Making Attributes Visible


As a System Admin user you'll be familiar with Field Configuration

Field Configuration allows you to switch on/off categories, interests and demographics which are then tagged against stakeholders.

You can choose which attributes are **visible** and **mandatory** for each project you have.

- 1. Go to System Admin
- 2. Under **Configuration** on the left-hand menu click **Field Configuration**
- Select the relevant project
- 4. Open up Stakeholder Mapping
- If you wish for attributes to be visible, click the check box next to each attribute

If you do not have System Admin access, please contact your dedicated CSM.




Start Mapping (1/2)

Once you have set up your attributes, you can start mapping stakeholders.

You'll see any existing Mappings you have set up inside the module, and from the left-hand menu you'll be able to **Add Stakeholder Mapping**





Start Mapping (2/2)

Select your **Mapping Name** – this may be related to a piece of work you're completing.

A **Description** will help steer the stakeholders and the attributes you should be mapping.

Select your **Phase 1 Start Date.** This is the date you will start mapping.

(You will have the ability to create additional phases later, if you wish to see attribute changes over a period).

Select the **Attributes** you wish to map against in this specific mapping. You can include a **Target Average**, e.g. 5 out of 10.

Owner Teams allows you to select which Tractivity license holder(s) can edit/add information.

Adding Stakeholders


Once you've created your mapping, you'll be able to start adding stakeholders.


Within our Stakeholder Mapping module, you can map **both organisations and contacts** in the same mapping.

- The option to Add Organisations and Add Contacts to Map is visible in the top lefthand menu.
- 2. Using Tractivity's Search functionality, you can find specific stakeholders based on the categories they have against them.

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Mapping Stakeholders – Option 1

There are two options for scoring stakeholders. This is Option 1:

When you've added your Contacts/Organisations you'll be able to map attributes & scores.


1. You can do this by clicking Map Stakeholder


You will be able to map stakeholders individually using the **Engagement Summary** and even see their **View Contact** page by opening the details in a new tab.

You can use the radio buttons to map your stakeholders 1 - 10 - 1 being Low, 10 being High.

When you're happy with the scores provided, click **Save & Exit**

You can repeat this process for each stakeholder in the mapping.






Mapping Stakeholders – Option 2

There are two options for scoring stakeholders. This is Option 2:

When you've added your Contacts/Organisations you'll be able to map attributes & scores.

- 1. You can do this by clicking Import Mappings
- Select the appropriate Phase you wish to score against and click **Download Template** (this will download in your Browser as an excel, example is the final image)
- 3. Once you've completed adding scores via the excel download, save this and drag the file/upload from your files here.

Top Tip: option 2 is beneficial if have a lot of stakeholders to map, but you won't have the Engagement Summary visible here.




Additional Phases

Our Stakeholder Mapping module allows you to use phases

Additional phases are beneficial if you have a project that has a longer timeline, giving you the opportunity to compare stakeholder scores with what was given in previous phases.

- 1. Click Map Stakeholders
- 2. From the dropdown, select **Phase X (Start New Phase)**
- Select your Phase X Start Date and click Map Stakeholders

You'll then be able to amend scores provided in phases and see a + or - change in the averages and **Export** results.






Visualise Stakeholders (1/2)

You can see your attribute scores for stakeholders on a graph with Y and X axis.

- 1. Click Visualise Mappings
- Choose an Attribute for both the X and Y axis, and which Phase data you'd like to see and click **Update Graph**





Visualise Stakeholders (2/2)


You can choose 1 attribute for the X axis and another for the Y axis as well as the phase data you'd like to view.

A PDF export provides a visual of the graph you can see in Tractivity

The different bubble options on your X/Y Graph is detailed on the following page.

Additional Filters

At the bottom of your X/Y graph you'll see 3 additional filter options.


This gives you the ability to see a third attribute in your graph.


Include Bubble Attribute will show enlarged bubble icons to indicate the scores for stakeholders.

Include Colour Attribute assigns different colours based on the scores for stakeholders

You won't see a third attribute option here. **View Shift From** allows you to see two phases and the changes across these phases.









Your axis view with 'View Shift From'


Use Mappings to create Distribution Lists (1/2)

Once you have created a Mapping, you can use this to send specific comms, such as stakeholders who have below average scores.

- 1. Head over to Distribution Lists and create a new list
- 2. Click Add Organisations/Contacts to List
- 3. From the Search screen click Settings
- Select Stakeholder Mapping from the Record Type dropdown
- 5. Add Mapping Name to Selected fields
- 6. Click Confirm









Use Mappings to create Distribution Lists (2/2)

- 7. You'll now see the field **Mapping Name.** You can use this to identify the stakeholders you wish to add to the Distribution List.
- 8. You can then choose a particular **Phase** and **Attribute Scores** so you can be specific on the stakeholders you pull through to your list.

For example, you could pull in all stakeholders who have scored below Average in certain Attributes and email them directly to increase this.
